Stairsafe is the most popular stairwell platform in use in the UK construction industry.

Stairsafe has sold over 5,000 units since its launch in 2003.

Stairsafe is the safest stairwell platform in the UK with no related reportable incidents since its launch in 2003.

Stairsafe is the easiest to use stairwell platform available, with a minimal number of components and a bespoke design specifically for stairwells.

Stairsafe is in use on hundreds of UK construction sites every day of the week.

Compliance:

Stairsafe is a bespoke access system for use on stairs and as such cannot fully comply with EN1004 (European standard for aluminium tower scaffolds) or EN131 (European standard for ladder, steps and trestles).

Stairsafe complies with the appropriate elements of both these standards e.g. Safe Working Loads, means of access, guardrail heights, etc.

Safe Working Load:
Stairsafe has a safe working load of 225kg.

The safe working load of 225kg allows for two men of average weight (80kg each) and a reasonable weight of tools and materials up to a weight of a further 65kg.

Training:

Due to its unique design, there is no PASMA or similar course which covers its use, however, to ensure that the product is used safely and in the way intended, all platforms are supplied with a user guide which can be used as the basis for safe assembly.
