Training - Stairsafe Access Platforms.

Further to your enquiry regarding Stairsafe training, we now have pleasure in responding with further details.

As you are aware, Stairsafe is an extremely safe and unique system for providing safe access within stairwells. Due to its unique design, there is no PASMA or similar course which covers its use, however, to ensure that the product is used safely and in the way intended, all platforms are supplied with a user guide which can be used as the basis for requisite training.

We do suggest to customers who wish to follow best practice where training is concerned, that a member of their staff train their operatives and where necessary sub-contractors in the manner of a simple toolbox talk. We have provided a simple checklist sheet for the trainer to use as a guide, but the simple basis of the training is to talk them through the user guide whilst assembling the product either on site or at your premises. Stairsafe can be demonstrated on a piece of ground with an adjacent wall, the platform is simply placed on the bottom rung of the ladder frame rather than one of the upper rungs which would be used when on a staircase.

Once training has been completed this can be recorded in the same manner as you would record any other training. We can also provide pre-printed training cards, which can be completed by yourselves and placed in the laminated sleeves provided. These cards can then be issued to the operatives as proof of training when on site.

GUIDE FOR STAIRSAFE TRAINER

Introduction to Stairsafe

- Simple solution to stairwell access
- Alternative to “ladder & scaffold board”
- Minimal Components
- Standard set suits vast majority of staircases
- Other platform lengths are available if required
- Stair access maintained when equipment in position
- Only have in position when working in stairwell area

User Guide

- Talk through user guide
- Give copy of user guide to each trainee
- Product Demonstration
- Show components
- Check components are fit for use and not damaged

Assembly Demonstration

- Frame and adjustable legs
- Platform complete ‘with second set of legs
- Guardrail Pack
- Braces (Note: when fixed, check and re-tighten if necessary)

Inspection

Prior to use stand back, ensure the equipment is erected properly and is suitable for the task.

Storage

When work complete store in secure location (trip hazard, theft)
